- Garbage Carts

 - If you live on a hill public works will assist with where to place garbage cans for special pick up.

 - The WISDOM Study is a partnership of breast health doctors and researchers, patient advocates, community leaders and women from all neighborhoods whose goal is to revolutionize the way breast cancer is detected and risk is reduced.
 - The WISDOM Study compares two approved screening approaches: annual mammograms for all women, starting at the age of 40 or a personalized approach to breast screening that is based on a woman's individual risk factors for breast cancer, like her breast density, genes, and family health history.
