 - Birmingham Amphitheater
 - Birmingham City Council approved the city's share of funding for a planned new \$50 million, 9,000-seat amphitheater at the site of the demolished former Carraway hospital.
 - Anticipated finish date is Spring 2025.
 - Code enforcement issue in the 5800 block of Crestwood Boulevard.
 - Ms. Bailey reported the resident has been fined and sent a request to remove the offending code violation.
 - Cresthill Road speed bumps.
 - Ms. Bailey reported they have relayed complaints to the Department of Transportation and are still awaiting a response.
