6. City Representatives

- India Bailey for Hunter Williams, Councilor - District 2
 - Update on the parcel on 12th Avenue South near right off 48th Street. The lot was recently put up for sale and advertised as shovel ready. They haven't done the work with the zoning office to start developing the property. She will keep us informed if anything happens. Due to the protected status, no trees can be cut down until November and it's a landslide & flood risk. Neighbors within 500 feet will be notified.
 - The issue with the power going out often was brought up. Alabama Power is separate from the city and not proactive about issues, but India & Hunter Williams will advocate for us.

 - The city budget is being passed the following day, June 24.
